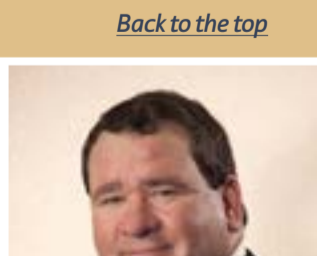
## Dave's Notes
